All residential water lines must be a minimum of one (1) inch service line.
All taps into the City sanitary sewer line shall be made by a current city licensed plumber, tap fee is \$250.
All excavations that expose the city sewer line shall be inspected.
All new or replacement sanitary sewer or potable water supply service lines shall be installed with a #12 solid copper tracer wire in compliance with the City's Tracer Wire Ordinance.
All fees shall be prepaid before services are rendered.
All plumbers shall be licensed with the City of Hiawatha. Exception: a resident home owner may perform his own plumbing work with the exception of main line tapping.
Owner or Contractor must contact **Kansas 1-800-DIG SAFE (1-800-344-7233) or 811** before proceeding with any excavation.

If the excavation site is not returned to its original condition, the City of Hiawatha will revoke the contractors' license until the repairs are complete.
