The City would like to remind citizens that **ONLY** limbs and brush are **ACCEPTED**. Leaves are accepted as well, but need to be dumped from plastic bags. Under state law, trash is **PROHIBITED** and is cause for immediate closure!

The City has provided this service to all citizens of Hiawatha and surrounding areas, so please report any persons violating the law to 785-742-2155. Please note that this property will also be monitored by cameras and City Staff.



It is the responsibility of all contractors, roofers, electricians, plumbers/mechanicals and tree trimmers to come to City Hall to register for a city license **up to two weeks prior** to starting a project. All roofers and/or roofing companies must be licensed with the Kansas State Attorney General's Office prior to performing work or soliciting business within the city limits. **This is a State Law!**

A permit must be obtained by the property owner or contractor before any work on the property can commence. **A permit can take up to 10 days for approval.**

**It is the responsibility of either the contractor or permit applicant to contact 1-800-DIG-SAFE!** The utilities have up to three business days to locate lines.

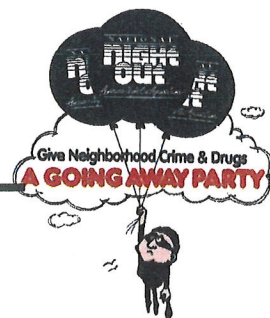
