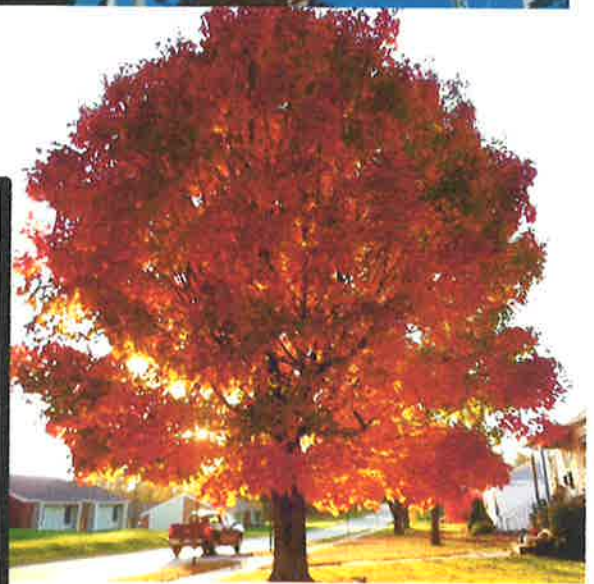


City of Beautiful Maples

It is the responsibility of all contractors, roofers, electricians, plumbers/mechanicals and tree trimmers to come to City Hall to register for a city license **up to two weeks prior** to starting a project. All roofers and/or roofing companies must be licensed with the Kansas State Attorney General's Office prior to performing work or soliciting business within the city limits. **This is a State Law!**

A permit must be obtained by the property owner or contractor before any work on the property can commence. **A permit can take up to 10 days for approval.**

It is the responsibility of either the contractor or permit applicant to contact 1-800-DIG-SAFE! The utilities have up to three business days to locate lines.



Hiawatha Municipal Code states that grass and weeds should not exceed 8 inches. Please keep your properties mowed and maintained as this shall lessen the possibility of unwanted animals and pests such as snakes, rats, raccoon, skunks, etc.

Just a Reminder: Anyone not officially named on a utility account, will NOT be able to receive information regarding that account. This includes, but not limited to, account balance, disconnect due to leaks/relocation, change of address.

Each household will be allowed one pickup load, one carload, or one single-axle trailer load. No contractors are allowed and the City reserves the right to refuse any load.

PROOF OF RESIDENCY WILL BE REQUIRED.

Accepted materials will include carpet, clothing, paper, cardboard, couches, chairs, mattresses, clean wood (no paint or varnish), shingles, tar paper, cabinets, tables, windows, porcelain, tubs, toilets, sinks, bikes, trikes, scooters, wire, metal cabinets/chairs, cooking and heating stoves, water tanks, metal sinks, appliances, iron, tin, televisions and computers.

Unacceptable items include household trash, leaves, grass clippings, tires, paint, oil, gas, hazardous materials, and any material containing Freon except appliances.
